VJAS Scholarship Opportunities!

The Virginia Junior Academy of Science awards numerous scholarships to students who participate in the annual conference. It is important that participants note that a separate application is necessary in order to be eligible for any of these scholarships. Also, applicants must present their paper during the conference in order to be eligible. Other criteria exist and vary depending upon each scholarship.

The Frances and Sydney Lewis Scholarship awards \$14,000 to the student who presents a project which contributes the most to environmental science.

The Bethel High School Scholarship is presented to the VJAS participant who has written an outstanding paper and is a 1st place winner in a category. This scholarship awards \$1,000.

The VCU scholarship awards \$2,000 to a senior who plans to attend VCU and has written an outstanding paper.

The ODU Scholarship awards \$2,000 to a senior who plans to attend ODU and has written an outstanding paper.

Other scholarships are available which pertain to other various universities and fields of study.

VJAS Criteria!

Appropriate length of for the written presentation is 12 pages not including the appendix, and not exceeding 20 pages including the appendix. No title page should be included, but instead a VJAS entry form. All sources used must be properly cited or else

this will be considered plagiarism. Sources such as Wikipedia are not acceptable, if internet sources are used they must be from a reliable scientific journal. Sources can also be digitalized for web access by a library with the original still present for examination. All papers
